

## Hull-York Lakeland RC&D Council 2011 Plan of Work

<u>Foreword:</u> The Hull-York Lakeland Resource Conservation and Development Area was authorized for planning on November 10, 1965. The Secretary of Agriculture approved the plan on October 15, 1966. It is the oldest and largest RC&D Council in Tennessee. In 1972, the Council expanded to its current capacity of the 14 counties in the Upper Cumberland region: Cannon, Clay, Cumberland, DeKalb, Fentress, Jackson, Macon, Overton, Pickett, Putnam, Smith, Van Buren, Warren, and White. It's total acreage is 3,195,480.

<u>Council Mission:</u> Provide leadership to local communities to improve the quality of life and conserve natural resources by organizing partners and facilitating technical and financial assistance resources.

<u>Council Goals:</u> The goals of the Hull-York Lakeland RC&D Area are based on four element categories identified in the RC&D area plan in compliance with Section 513.B of the USDA-NRCS Resource Conservation & Development Program Manual.

- <u>Matural LAND CONSERVATION</u> Improve land resources through natural resources management and conservation.
- **MANAGEMENT Improve the utilization and protection of land resources.**
- **WATER MANAGEMENT** Improve the management of water resources.
- Machieve community sustainability.
